





#### **Cabin Notes**

- Cabin has one additional bed in the form of a single sofa bed
- Cabin has two additional beds in the form of a double sofa bed
- Cabin has two additional beds in the form of pull-down beds
- Fixed double bed
- Cabin has a chair instead of a sofa Cabins with interconnecting doors Steel fronted balcony
- Cabins with shower only
- View over decks rather than sea view
- Balcony visible from above and/or neighbouring balconies

 Cabin is partially shaded
Cabin has steps to entrance
All adapted cabins have a shower only
Note: All pull-down beds in twin cabins are accessible via a ladder. When pull-down beds are in use, lower beds cannot be converted to a double. Balconies in the forward section of the ship can be overlooked by the bridge.
