

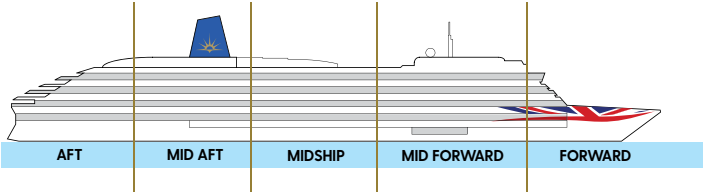

Cabin Notes

- * Sleeps 3; includes a single sofa bed
- ** Sleeps 4; includes a double sofa bed
- ◇ Sleeps 4; includes two pull-down beds
- ⊗ Fixed double bed
- ▲ Cabin has a chair instead of a sofa
- Cabins with interconnecting doors
- # Steel fronted balcony
- ❖ Cabins with shower only
- 👁 View over decks rather than sea view
- ∨ Balcony visible from above and/or neighbouring balconies
- ♠ Balcony is partially shaded
- ♿ All adapted cabins have a shower only
- 🚪 Suitable for a powered mobility device

Note: all pull-down beds in twin cabins are accessible via a ladder. When pull-down beds are in use, lower beds cannot be converted to a double. Balconies in the forward section of the ship can be overlooked by the bridge.
